- One key significance of the AGS Diamond Grading Standards Manual is that it is the first of its kind to include standards for all 4Cs, including cut. This is important because cut can affect the value of a diamond by more than 50%.
- To celebrate the anniversary, the American Gem Society has a special section on cut, which began when the American Gem Society in 1966 developed a cut grade, moved into high gear with the publication of the new diamond cut grading system by the Gemological Institute of America this year.
