This does run, revs up good and seems to have plenty of power. The 16" bar and chain looks like it hasn't been used a lot. The saw does have scuffs, scratches and paint loss from normal use. This mid-size saw now offers a decompression valve for easier starts, and a combination of performance features that make each job go a little faster. Rated 3 out of 5 by NorthwoodsMark from MS261 Light Duty Saw I purchased this saw, MS261CM because of the Professional rating. I cut 15 face cords a year. My previous saw was a McCulloch ProMac 10-10. This saw is lighter and handles well. My saw has an 18" bar and .325 chain. Chainsaws. There is a wide variety of chainsaws available on the market.
